*synonyms: liberty, liberation, release, emancipation, deliverance, delivery, discharge, non-confinement, extrication; More*


*antonyms: captivity*





1913-1941




She is remembered as Indian, Hungarian, bisexual, high-class woman who told stories of lower-class women in India

1907-1954


Bisexual Mexican artist Frida Kahlo has become an international icon for the power and intensity of her art, and the extraordinary suffering she experienced in her life.
