Announcement of Admission to Undergraduate Programmes of the University of Delhi for the Academic Session 2026-27

The University of Delhi announces the commencement of Phase I of registration for admission to its various Undergraduate Programmes for the Academic Session 2026-27.

Candidates who appeared in the Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG) – 2026] and are desirous of seeking admission to the Colleges of the University of Delhi (UoD) are advised to register themselves on the Common Seat Allocation System - 2026 (CSAS(UG)-2026) portal (<https://ugadmission.uod.ac.in>).

Admissions to 73 Programmes and more than a hundred B.A. Programmes offered in 67 Colleges of the university will be done solely on the basis of the scores obtained in CUET (UG) - 2026, fulfilling the programme-specific eligibility published in the UG Bulletin of Information 2026-27.

Candidates can register on the CSAS portal through their CUET(UG)-2026 Application Number only. In line with the university's initiative to ensure a secure and hassle-free registration experience, candidates' essential credentials, such as Name, Date of Birth (DOB), Photograph, and Signature, have been auto-integrated via the secure API Setu of GoI. This eliminates the hassle of managing duplicate data, thereby strengthening data security and minimising student-specific entry errors.

PHASE II OF REGISTRATION

After completing Phase I, the candidates must also provide their preferences for Programme + College combinations they wish to pursue. This will be Phase II of CSAS.

In Phase II of CSAS, the candidates will have to map the CUET test papers with the subjects studied in Class XII. It must be noted that for ascertaining the Programme-specific eligibility, only those CUET(UG)-2026 Language and/or Domain-specific papers will be considered in which the candidate has passed Class XII. Based on the subject-mapping, the University will ascertain the eligibility of the candidate and will calculate the cumulative score for all the

Programmes in which a candidate is found eligible. Thereafter, the candidates will be required to provide their preferences for the Programme/s and College/s.

The schedule for Phase II of CSAS will be announced shortly.

Before applying, candidates are strongly advised to refer to the UG Bulletin of Information and the CSAS (UG) 2026-27 rules available on the website to understand the minimum eligibility, program-specific requirements, and allocation guidelines.

All candidates are advised to regularly visit the official admission website (admission.uod.ac.in) for subsequent updates, schedules, and official announcements.
