17. GREEN SENSE AT A DELHI COLLEGE: ECO-AUDIT AND BEST PRACTICES FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT¹

INTRODUCTION: There is an urgent need to create ecologically aware critical communities in our educational institutions. The benefits of creation of such communities are tremendous. According to 'Green Sense: Educational Campus Inventory' developed by CSE (2017), there are 45 central universities in India, 318 state universities, 185 state private universities, 129 deemed universities, 55 autonomous institutes of national importance and 37,204 registered colleges having approximately three crore students. If the student community, the teaching and the nonteaching staff of the educational institutions are trained to develop green sense, it can over the years have a tonic effect in creating sustainable living practices in the wider society. The educational institutions can become eco-labs where the best practices in sustainable development can be dialogued, implemented systematically and critically analyzed in terms of process and endpoints. The college students are budding professionals and also future parents and citizens. They have capacity to be self-reflective and understand the vast scope of the environmental disaster that looms in front of us. The institutions can 'seed' critical transformative attitudes and practices in the student community whereby they can become self-regulated users of the resources of our fragile Earth.

In the present study, we document the recent efforts of the College in systematically studying the ecology of the campus through initiating an Eco Audit facilitated by CSE, document existing best practices of sustainable development and initiation of new projects based on the suggestions that emerged from the initial findings of the eco-audit.

To summarize, the specific objectives of this paper are:

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GARGI COLLEGE

Gargi College was established in July 1967 by the Delhi Administration to promote higher education among young women. The College offers an excellent example of how campaigns and policies can trigger change without the need for any major infrastructural modifications. A dedicated and passionate 'green' initiatives team, coupled with strong awareness campaigns, workshops and open-house talks have turned Gargi College into one of the more environmentally-conscious campuses in the capital.



CSE AND GARGI - THE ASSOCIATION

In 2017, CSE and Gargi College signed an MoU under the Green Campus Initiative. The association has resulted in extensive sensitisation of the faculty, students and staff of the College. It has helped them plan campaigns, and has trained them to generate knowledge for understanding the environmental performance of their campus - by preparing baselines, benchmarking, methods for improvement, strategies, etc. Most importantly, all this has been made a part of the College's curriculum.

For instance, CSE has trained a batch of third year students of the Bachelor in Elementary Education course to collect data and prepare an environmental baseline for the campus. The batch has been awarded for this exercise as a part of the course curriculum.

A GREEN CAMPUS COMPENDIUM

Education and awareness

The campus authorities, in association with the College's green committee, have been regularly holding campaigns and workshops with a view to generate environmental sensitivity in not only the students and staff but also their families. The College has been organising plantation drives in which more than 1,000 saplings have been distributed. The campus has also adopted a herd of gifting potted plants to its special guests and visitors with a view to encourage tree plantation. A Sacred Garden has been set up in the College, where trees considered to be sacred in India have been documented. The College has also documented the botanical and ecological identity of its trees on the campus. A 'Fertiliser Aard' has been introduced. It is given to students who find innovative solutions to every-day problems. The initiative is aimed at encouraging student research on environmental subjects. Some of the subjects which have been taken up for research projects include information on sanitary napkins, hazards of aluminum teaching, ecological awareness in schools, green tourism, hazards of packaged food and benefits of organic food, etc.

The College's 'Meera Mug' programme has been one such flagship project for researching on solid waste management on campus. Under it, students collected information related to solid waste management and conducted awareness programmes to sensitize their counterparts on waste management, with the focus on single-use plastics. The use of reusable containers, reusable handbags, solar panels, algae plants and compost pits were showcased in the project. After the research, the students working under Meera Mug hosted a social media awareness campaign as well. The College Eco-Club regularly conducts workshops in which students are encouraged to prepare their own waste and sharpsheet. This has led to reaching results as it encourages them to generate less packaging waste beyond the campus.

Harnessing the sun
The campus has installed solar PV panels that feed 60 solar-powered energy lights inside the campus.

A zero-waste campus
Gargi College generates 255 litres of waste every day. Disruption is a key motto on the campus, which has 60 colour-coded bins – 42 (green bins) of these are for biodegradable waste and wet organic waste, 10 blue ones are for paper waste, three yellow ones are for lightweight packaging, plastics and metals and four red bins are for hazardous waste. The entire waste collected from the campus is funnelled into compact in two on-site composting pits.

The College is also experimenting with a biogas plant using the kitchen waste. To become a zero-waste campus, initiatives like banning the use of plastic bags, straws and cups inside the campus have been undertaken. Campaigns such as 'Bring Your Own Mug' sensitize students and teachers to reduce the use of plastic as much as possible. Another campaign called 'Don't Cup' encourages students to avoid PVC plastic cups which the student can then exchange for a mug.



Catching the rain
The campus has a potential rain-catching area (including the rooftop and surface area) of 1,800 square metres. It has a rainwater harvesting system with a capacity of 800 cubic metres or 800,000 litres. Rainwater is harvested at three separate locations on the campus. The rooftop rainwater is first channelled into collection-leading channels. The water is then managed into a harvesting structure which has a 35-m-deep base and. The College organises rainwater harvesting sensitisation walks for its students.


